Generational Brokenness to Blessing

Here is a recap of what we talked about in this week's video!

The three specific questions:

- 1. How can we partner with God in addressing our generational brokenness?
- 2. How do we see generational brokenness in our lives and lineage?
- 3. How do we release blessing over our family line?

1. How can we partner with God in addressing our generational brokenness?

Often times it begins with **identifying the root experience or event of brokenness that led to the tendency, pattern, or idea.** Then, we are able to recognize how that has impacted the view of ourself or other family members. Here are examples of how they may manifest in each:

2. How do we see generational brokenness in our lives and lineage?

Three forms we or past members of our family can experience generational brokenness. Through:

Vows: Something you have spoken over yourself

Agreements: Something someone has spoken over you

Curses: Something you have spoken over someone

Vows, Agreements, and Curses act as spiritual entry points that create a partnership with brokenness and sin.

A VOW: Something you have spoken over yourself

AN AGREEMENT: Something someone has spoken over

Event of Brokenness	Partnering with Brokenness
My child says, "I hate you. You are the worst."	" Yes, I am a bad parent "
My parent said I was a failure	"Yes they were right , I am a failure and I cannot provide for my family"

A CURSE: Something you have spoken over someone

Event of Brokenness	Partnering with Brokenness
A family member does something behind my back	"They can never be trusted"
A family member makes a mistake	"They will never change"

3. How do we release blessing over our family line?

We must **break our partnership with brokenness and partner with God**. We can then ask Holy Spirit to break unhealthy generational ties and **claim God's biblical truth over us and our lineage.**

A BLESSING: "Bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you."-Luke 6:28

A family member makes a mistake	"They will nover change"	" I surrender them to you and any bitterness I may have against them."

Exercise

Take some time to reflect on your own family and experiences below through this prayer. Pray that during this time, you and your family will be protected.

Pray that God will reveal if there are any events or experiences where generational brokenness has occurred.

Pray that God reveal if there are ways you have partnered with that brokenness. If he reveals anything, you can fill in the "Partnering with Brokenness" Box

Break any areas of generational brokenness and partner with the Holy Spirit. Ask for God to reveal his blessing and hope over each area you have surrendered to Him. Once He reveals them to you. Pray them over yourself out loud.

Cross out the "Partnering with Brokenness Box" and write down what God revealed to you in the last box.
